

 - Banana Stem/Bark
 - Bamboo Sticks, Twigs, or Soft Wood Scraps
 - Dried Coconut Shells
 - Clay/Soil
 - Leaves (large leaves like Peepal, Banyan, or Sal for sails)
 - Flowers and Flower Petals
 - Natural Pigments (e.g., Turmeric, Sindoor (Vermillion) powder, or natural mud colors for painting)
 - Earthen Diyas (Lamps) filled with natural oil (must be clay).
